Improve Your Writing!

- Graduate work can be frustrating if your academic writing competency is not where it should be. We recommend the following options depending on the level of help you need.
 - Have a fellow student edit your written assignments and coach you on how to improve.
 - Enroll in RES 512 Academic Writing. Receive a total of 13 hours of classroom instruction in a weekend module, and up to 20 hours of one-to-one coaching. This one-hour, noncredit course will be offered in the spring semester at **half** the regular tuition rate. Enrollment reached maximum capacity by the beginning of Fall 2012, so be sure to sign up early for Spring.
