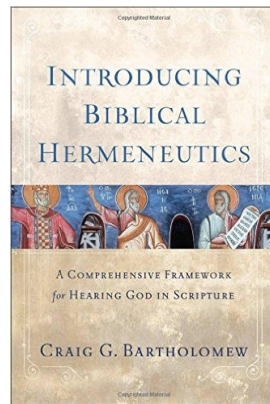

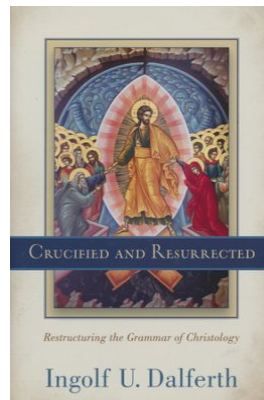
Spring Library Hours
