Spring 2015 Registration

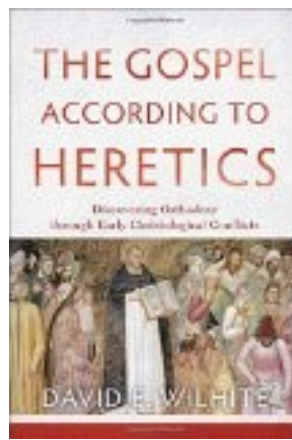
The library hours over the extended Thanksgiving weekend will be as follows:

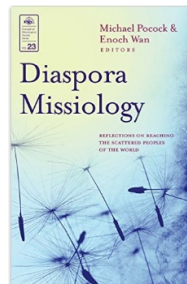
