Deferred Payment Dates

- Accounts not paid in full on or before the first day of the semester will incur a "Deferred Payment Fee" of \$50.
- Deferred payments (1/3 of term charges remaining after institutional aid is factored in) must be made on or before the following dates:
 - o August 22
 - o October 15
 - o November 15

Late Payment Fee

 Any student account with a debit balance that does not receive payment during a given month will be charged a \$25 late payment fee.

Student Refund Checks

Planning to complete all degree requirements by or before August 2015?

To graduate in December 2014: Complete and submit the 2014-15 graduation application to the AGTS Registrar's Office by October 30.

- To graduate in the spring or summer 2015 semester: complete and submit the <u>2014-15 graduation</u> <u>application</u> to the AGTS <u>Registrars Office</u> by <u>January</u> 30, 2015.
- Students graduating this fall or next spring (and those approved to graduate next summer) will all participate in the May 2015 Commencement Service.
