## Business Office News

### 2013-2014 Tuition and Fees

- Tuition covers 65-70% of the cost of education at AGTS.
- The rest is funded by a grant from the General Council of the Assemblies of God and the contributions of churches, districts, and individuals.
- The tuition rate effective fall 2013 is \$559 per credit hour, a 3% increase over the current tuition rate.
- Accounts paid in full on or before the first day of the semester are eligible for a 1% rebate on net tuition.
- Net tuition is the full tuition charge less tuition discounts and institutional scholarships.

- If you have not yet completed financial registration for the fall or summer terms, please stop by the Business Office as soon as possible and sign your promissory note.
