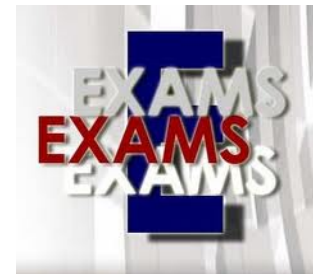

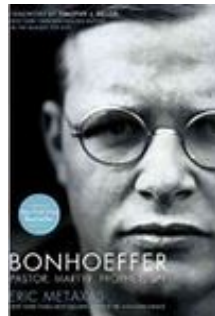


Library Closed for Holidays

- Regular hours resume on Monday, January 5.

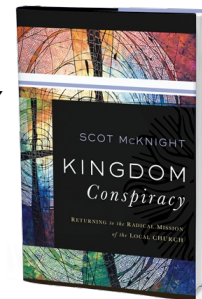
New Books at the AGTS Library

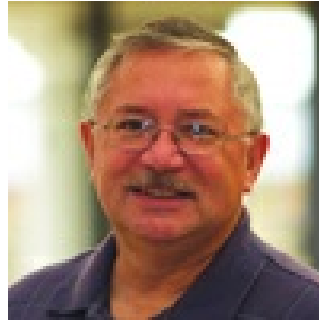
