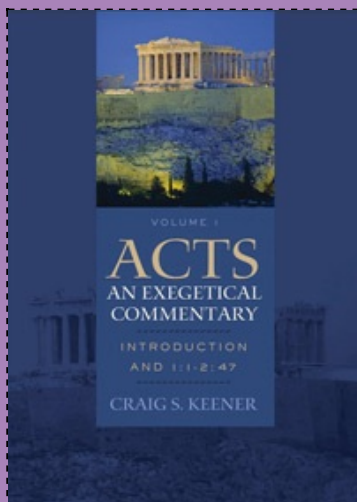
### Alumni Prayerathon

## Alumni News & Publications

- Baker Academic has released the second volume of **Craig Keener's** (1985/1987 alum) four-volume commentary, *Acts: An Exegetical Commentary: 3:1-14:28*. In this volume, Keener continues his detailed exegesis of Acts, utilizing an unparalleled range of ancient sources and offering a wealth of fresh insights.
- Keener (Ph.D., Duke University) is professor of New Testament at Asbury Theological Seminary in Wilmore, Kentucky. He is the author of many books, including the bestseller *The IVP Bible Background Commentary: New Testament, Miracles: The Credibility of the New Testament Accounts, The Historical Jesus of the Gospels, Gift and Giver*, and commentaries on Matthew, John, Romans, 1-2 Corinthians and Revelation.
- **Mark Wootton's** (2003 alum) book, *The Complete Pentecostal: More Than Just Tongues*, is being published chapter by chapter in upcoming issues of *Spiritual Resources*, which is the pastoral journal for Eastern Europe published by Life Publishers. It will be translated into Albanian, Croatian, Czech, French, German, Hungarian, Polish, and Romanian.
